

- On February 11, 2016, the Park Board voted to solicit the public for suggestions in naming the park.
- Parks and Recreation Department solicited name suggestions from the public via an online submittal form.
- The online submittal form was posted to the City's website on 3/29/2016.
- The online submittal form was promoted via social media, Facebook and Nextdoor. It was also featured on the City website's homepage as a scrolling banner.
- The deadline for submittals for this park was 4/12/16, allowing citizens two weeks to submit names.
- All submittals were sent to the PROS Board for their consideration and a final recommendation to the City Council was decided on July 14, 2016.

BOARD OR COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION:

- The PROS Board recommends to the City Council to name the 16-acre neighborhood park site at 1849 Reagan Drive, "Monarch Park", with "George Webb Park" and "Dr. Mack Moran Hill Park" as alternatives.
