

**TITLE:** Consider/Discuss/Act on Making a Recommendation to the City Council for Naming a Park within the Craig Ranch Town Center, Located South of Collin McKinney Parkway and between Meyer Way and Rundell Way

## **RECOMMENDED PROS BOARD ACTION:**

• Recommend to the City Council a Name(s) for a new park within Craig Ranch.

## **ITEM SUMMARY:**

- Naming of a Park is typically coordinated with the project's construction, which is soon to begin.
- The City's naming policy requires that the Parks Board provides a name or names to the City Council for consideration, in accordance with the guidelines set forth by City Council.
- Generally, a name(s) should be selected based on the following: Outstanding and/or predominant geographical or physical features of the land; Outstanding and/or predominant historical features of significance; Contributions of land for a park site; or in honor of a community/state leader or hero.
- This park is located south of Collin McKinney Parkway and between Rundell Way and Myer Way.
- This park has been referred to as Arc Park, due to the arcs that have been incorporated into the design through the walkways and planting areas. This could be a potential name should the Board recommend it.

## BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- This is a park that is required per the Craig Ranch VCIM agreement and is in satisfaction of the city's parkland dedication ordinance.
- Per that agreement, the developer is required to construct a number of predetermined parks. The park is owed by the City but constructed and maintained by the Craig Ranch HOA.
- This is an urban park that includes a plaza area, sculptural features, terraced seating, open space, walkways, and landscaping. Visually, this is located at a primary entrance into the area off of Collin McKinney Parkway and Alma Road.
