**RECOMMENDED CITY COUNCIL ACTION:**

- Approve Resolution to redirect \$10,477 in unspent funds from FY18 Arts Commission budget to the FY18 Public Art Fund balance

**ITEM SUMMARY:**

- In FY18, the City Council allocated \$200,000 to the McKinney Arts Commission to further the Arts Commission mission *"to create a vibrant and viable arts community in which diverse, high quality arts opportunities are available to McKinney residents and visitors."*

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- City Council approved Resolution 2013-11-107(R) which stated "that any unspent funds allocated annually to the Arts Commission for support of the Arts in McKinney may be redirected to the Public Art Fund"
- The Public Art fund current balance is \$67,218 but will be \$36,945 after current Public Art Projects are completed

**FINANCIAL SUMMARY:**

- There are \$10,477 in unspent FY18 Arts Commission funds that may be redirected to the Public Art Fund, with City Council approval.
