**ITEM SUMMARY:**

- Parks and Recreation staff will lead a discussion and workshop session related to the various renovation options at Finch Park. Feedback from this session will be forwarded to the design team for incorporation into their planning efforts.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- The Finch Park Improvements Project (PK1211) is a FY17-18 Capital Improvements Program funded by Bonds, MCDC, and Parkland Dedication funds in an amount of \$1,900,000.
- The Finch Park Improvements may include but not be limited to: replacement of playground equipment and splash pad, more concrete trails, additional park shelters, pedestrian bridges, tennis court renovations, modifications to the existing storm system, additional parking, and miscellaneous improvements.
- In August of 2018, City Council approved a professional services contract for landscape architectural and engineering services with JBI Partners, Inc.
- Exhibits from JBI will be presented and thoroughly discussed at the meeting.
