- On February 5, 2019, the McKinney City Council approved the placement of a bond package of \$350 million on the May 4, 2019 ballot.
- The following items represent the proposed propositions and amounts identified for consideration:
 - \$75 million for Public Safety
 - \$50 million for a Municipal Community Complex
 - \$91 million for Parks & Recreation Facilities
 - \$34 million for Public Works Facilities
 - \$100 million for Transportation
