

TITLE: Consider/Discuss Promotional and Community Event Grant Application Submitted by McKinney ISD Department of Athletics (PC #20-16) in the Amount of \$15,000 for the Advertising, Marketing and Promotion of the 2020 NCAA Division II Championship Football Game.

ITEM SUMMARY:

- In December 2018, the McKinney ISD Department of Athletics, in conjunction with the Lone Star Conference, hosted the NCAA Division II Football National Championship at MISD's new, state-of-the-art athletics stadium.
- The NCAA Championship game will be televised on ESPN 2 or 3 showcasing McKinney and its stadium on national television.
- The 2020 Championship Game will be held on Saturday, December 19 time is TBD.
- Supporting events such as Fan Fest and Tacos, Tequila and Cerveza will be held Thursday, December 17 through Game Day.
- Goals established for the event include an increase of 20% increase in visitors to McKinney in 2020; 20% increase in attendance and 10% increase in hotel rooms booked.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The mission of the McKinney ISD Department of Athletics is to provide an opportunity to supplement the educational process of students who exhibit an interest in athletics and wat a forum to challenge their physical and emotional capabilities.
- In March of 2019, the NCAA announced a contract had been awarded to MISD Athletics, in conjunction with McKinney ISD and the City of McKinney to host the Division II Football Championship game for three years 2019, 2020, 2021.

- High profile events, such as the NCAA Division II championship provide an opportunity to showcase McKinney, spur the hospitality industry and drive tourism.
- An economic impact study commissioned by McKinney ISD Athletics shows that the state and local economy could see \$1.1 million in economic gain as a result of hosting this game.
- Discussions with Chestnut Square Historic Village and McKinney Food Tours about the possibility of collaborating on expanding events offered during Championship weekend.

FINANCIAL SUMMARY:

- MCDC's allocation for Promotional and Community Event grants for this cycle is \$75,000.
- McKinney ISD Department of Athletics was awarded a grant in the amount of \$14,625 in FY 19 Cycle II for promotion of the 2019 Championship.
