ITEM SUMMARY:

- Thirteen (13) grant applications were received totaling \$184,325 in grant requests.
- Thirteen (13) organizations are recommended for Season Grant funding.
- Funding is only provided to support events or programs held within the City of McKinney. This includes funding awarded to any non-McKinney based organizations.

- \$3,000 is being recommended to provide a City membership into the Dallas Business Council for the Arts and attendance for one Commissioner to the Collin County Leadership Arts Institute.
- \$10,000 is being requested to support Arts in Bloom, Juried Art Show, and special Art Exhibits.
- \$2,000 is requested for the web-based Arts grant application.

FINANCIAL SUMMARY:

• The approved Fiscal Year 2021 Budget includes \$200,000 from General Fund to support the arts in McKinney.
