### ITEM SUMMARY:

- The City of McKinney provides School Resource Officers (SRO) to the Frisco Independent School District (FISD).
- The contract outlines the following cost sharing arrangement for FISD:
  - One (1) Officer at 50% of step 7 salary/benefits
  - One (1) pursuit vehicle at 50% of depreciation
- The contract allows for an automatic one-year renewal with updated salary/benefit rates.

### BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The 2015-16 agreement provided for 50% of one (1) SRO's salary/benefits without vehicle depreciation.

- The vehicle depreciation was calculated on a six year life expectancy of a \$60,000 fully equipped police pursuit vehicle.

**FINANCIAL SUMMARY:**

- Fisd will pay the contract amount of \$57,657 for the 2016-17 School Resource Officer Program.
