ITEM SUMMARY:

- This Resolution authorizes the execution of an Agreement with the Texas Department of • Transportation (TxDOT) for the temporary closures of the northbound east lane of Custer Road (FM 2478) between Collin McKinney Parkway and Stacy Road for three (3) special events.
- The temporary single lane closure will begin approximately thirty minutes before the special • event starts for the day and the lane will be reopened to traffic at the conclusion of each event.
- Each temporary lane closure is estimated to extend for four (4) hours. •

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Cooper Fitness Center of Craig Ranch submitted an application for a special event permit with the City of McKinney for three (3) Sprint Triathlons in 2017: May 20, July 15, and September 9.

Pass

- The bicycle course of each triathlon begins and ends at Cooper Fitness Center with a portion of the race course on northbound Custer Road between Collin McKinney Parkway and Stacy Road.
- This is the same race route Cooper Fitness Center had for the previous triathlons.
- A temporary closure along state right of way requires an agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) for each year.

FINANCIAL SUMMARY:
