- Heritage Guild of Collin County is requesting a grant in the amount of \$10,000 for marketing, promotion and advertising of the following Chestnut Square events: 2017 Farmer's Market - fall season; Legends of McKinney Ghost Walk; 2017 Holiday Home Tour.
- The events will be held during the time period from August through December, 2017.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The mission of Heritage Guild of Collin County is to preserve and perpetuate the heritage of Collin County.
- HGCC was organized more than 40 years ago.
- HGCC supports Chestnut Square Historic Village - a McKinney museum and tourist destination offering diverse programs and activities throughout the year.

FINANCIAL SUMMARY:

- MCDCC's allocation for Promotional and Community Event grants for this cycle is \$50,000.

- MCDC has granted HGCC \$125,900 in promotional and community event grant funding since 2006.
