### ITEM SUMMARY:

- Staff will provide updates on bus procurement, job access, and grocery shuttle service.
- Bus procurement:
  - The City of McKinney will be purchasing a 13 passenger, wheelchair accessible Arboc "Spirit of Independence" bus
  - Manufacture lead time is approximately 9 - 12 weeks
  - The quote and floor plan documents are attached
  - The bus will be purchased using federal funds with a combination of Transit Development Credits (TDCs) and state funds as local match
- Job access:
  - Document attached.
  - CCT is being utilized to access employment in McKinney, Plano, Allen, Prosper, Frisco, and Princeton
- Grocery shuttle:
  - CCT is utilizing one of the buses to transport residents of Towne Creek, Country Lane, Grand Texan, and Grand Reserve apartments to grocery stores
  - Staff has received tremendous positive feedback

- Staff is gauging interest of other communities to expand service

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- The Board authorized staff to move forward with utilizing Section 5339 funds to procure a third bus on January 16, 2019.
