- Establishes re-inspection timeline and procedures.

## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- This item was tabled from the September 17<sup>th</sup> Council Meeting.
- Council directed Staff to establish a timeline for re-inspections of food establishments.
- Staff invited permit holders in July to an open forum discussion to discuss changed and provide feedback.
