- The proposed amendment to Chapter 7: Historically Underutilized Business (HUB) Program identifies the City's commitment in working with businesses certified as a HUB and outlines the procedures taken to actively involve HUBs in both the informal and formal procurement process and ensure they receive a fair opportunity to compete for our business.
- The Procurement Services Department maintains the following objectives:
 - $\circ~$ Identify HUB suppliers through the State of Texas HUB database.
 - Provide HUB supplier outreach and awareness of McKinney's procurement procedures, including electronic bidding.
 - Maintain a HUB supplier webpage on the City website to provide education and HUB supplier resource links.
 - Exceed state requirements for HUB supplier notification of bid opportunities by

inviting HUBs to participate in formal solicitations.
