ITEM SUMMARY:

- The U.S. Department of Transportation has made American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) Grant available to general aviation airports, through the Texas Department of Transportation. The Texas Department of Transportation acts as agent for the U.S. Department of Transportation for the purposes of applying for, receiving and distributing all aviation grant funds for Texas general aviation airports.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The McKinney National Airport has received an offer of financial assistance in the form of a 100% grant of approximately \$148,000, from the Texas department of Transportation.
- The funds can be used for costs related to operations, personnel, cleaning, sanitation,

janitorial services, combating the spread of pathogens at the airport, and debt service payments.

FINANCIAL SUMMARY:

- The Grant reimburses the McKinney National Airport for 100% of qualifying expenses and revenue shortfalls and requires no matching funds.
