 - the City Council may meet in work session, without action, to discuss preferencing nominations, prior to the special meeting held to appointment members.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

 Each board consists of members appointed to two-year terms with approximately half of all terms expiring in staggered years. File #: 22-0747, Version: 1

- The City Council may fill expired terms with incumbent or new members. Additionally, the Council may remove / replace members with unexpired terms at any time, with or without cause.
- Nearly 120 new candidates and incumbent members applied to serve on the various boards & commissions in 2022, with almost 71% of those participating in candidate interviews.
