ITEM SUMMARY:

- The General Election will be held to elect Mayor, Council members for District 1, District 3, and one At-Large on Saturday, May 6, 2017,
- The Ordinance provides for the following:
 - Date and hours of voting on election day: Saturday, May 6, 2017 from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.
 - Early Voting Polling locations within the City of McKinney proposed this year are:
 - McKinney Performing Arts Center
 - Collin County Elections Office in McKinney
 - Fire Station #5
- Proposed McKinney polling locations for election day are:
 - City Hall
 - Slaughter Elementary School
 - John and Judy Gay Library
 - Fire Station #5
- MISD/Collin College have selected two other McKinney polling locations for both Early Voting and Election Day.
 - Collin College Central Park Campus
 - Collin College Higher Education Center
- Voters can vote at any early voting location and election day Vote Centers administered by Collin County Elections Administration.

Saturday, April 29, 2017	8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
Monday, May 1, 2017	7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
Tuesday, May 2, 2017	7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- Appointment of Bruce Sherbet, Collin County Elections Administrator, as the Early Voting Clerk for the purpose of conducting early voting.

FINANCIAL SUMMARY:

- The City's cost for this Election will be approximately \$30,000 that includes the contract with Collin County Elections Administrator to conduct the City Council General Election, translation, voter's guide, advertisement, and legal notices.
