RECOMMENDED CITY COUNCIL ACTION:

- Approve Updates to the Wrecker Services Ordinance
- Consider and set new rates for Non-Consent Towing occurring within the City of McKinney.

ITEM SUMMARY:

- Sec 114 of the city ordinances specifies how the McKinney Police Departments administers and uses private towing companies for non-consent tow in the City of McKinney.
- Council sets the rate that authorized towing companies can charge a vehicle owner for nonconsent tows performed by the McKinney Police Department.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- This ordinance has not been updated since 2008. Several position titles have been changed, and certain requirements for the towing companies are no longer needed.
- The current non-consent tow rates were last addressed in 2008. Market conditions for the tow
 company owners have changed and they are requesting an increase in the non-consent tow
 rates they are allowed to charge vehicle owners.
