- Funding of \$12,000 is requested from the Public Art Fund as match for available TCA grant funds
- The grant would fund public artwork in the form of butterflies, created by McKinney artists, and placed at strategic locations within the Cultural District.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The City of McKinney has obtained a Cultural District Designation.
- The Texas Commission on the Arts has grant funding available to support projects in designated Cultural Districts.
- In 2018, the City of McKinney signed the National Wildlife Federation's Monarch Pledge, supporting the creation of beneficial ecosystems to ensure the future of the monarch butterfly and other pollinators.

FINANCIAL SUMMARY:
