- Ovation Performance Academy is requesting \$15,000 for the advertising, marketing and promotion of nine performances in the 2020-2021 season.
- The shows will include Yellow Boat (10/2-4); Carrie (1/28-30-21); 13 (4/30-5/2/20); Frozen Jr. (12/4-6/2020); Descendants Jr. (5/21-23/21); Toxic Avenger (10/23-25/20, 10/30-11/1/20); American Idiot (3/19-21, 3/26-28/21); Be More Chill (4/23-25/20, 4/30-5/2/20); Deferred Action/White Noise (TBD)
- Ticket prices are \$10-20 depending upon venue.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- Ovation Academy is a unique School of Performing arts with onsite training in the disciplines of Dance, Acting, Musical Theatre and Theatrical Production & Design as well as the business of being a professional artist and the life-skills needed to succeed in the industry.
