**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY,  
TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS UNDER OPIOID  
SETTLEMENT FUND**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, values the quality of life of all residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Opioid Crisis continues to impact our McKinney communities and families; and

**WHEREAS**, the City wishes to work support efforts to reduce and eliminate opioid impacts through direct treatment of opioid use and disorders and any co-occurring substance use disorder.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:**

Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby authorizes the additional disbursement of \$41,000, the balance of funding available within the city's dispersal under the Opioid Settlement Fund, to the organization Grace to Change, and will be administered through the Housing & Community Development Department, to benefit residents in need.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
