## RESOLUTION NO. 2024-06-XXX (R)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT, IF AWARDED, THE PATRICK LEAHY BULLETPROOF VEST PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM GRANT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025 ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

- WHEREAS, The Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) was created in 1984 to reduce violent crime, create safer communities, and reform our Nation's criminal justice system.; and
- WHEREAS, the McKinney Police Department applied for the Patrick Leahy Bulletproof Vest Partnership (BVP) Program grant for fiscal year 2024-2025, whereby said funds would be used to reimburse 50% of the cost to purchase bulletproof vests for officers, with the City of McKinney ("City") required to provide matching funds for the remaining 50%; and
- **WHEREAS,** in the event of loss or misuse of the BVP grant funds, the City would be required to return any applicable funds to the Department of Justice in full pursuant to the terms of the BVP Grant; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, desires to ratify the City Manager's application for, and if awarded, acceptance of the Patrick Leahy Bulletproof Vest Partnership (BVP) Program grant for fiscal year 2024-2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF McKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, hereby approves this Resolution ratifying the City Manager's application for and acceptance of, if awarded, the Patrick Leahy Bulletproof Vest Partnership (BVP) Program grant for Fiscal Year 2025 from the Department of Justice for officer bulletproof vests.
- Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of its passage, and it is so resolved.
