

RESOLUTION NO. 24-XXXX (R)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, IF AWARDED, TO ACCEPT AND IMPLEMENT AN ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTER GRANT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY THROUGH THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) TO PURCHASE ADDITIONAL AUTOMATIC EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS (AEDs)

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, understands the importance of automatic external defibrillators (AEDs) to be used by first responders and bystanders to improve patient outcomes from a sudden cardiac arrest; and

WHEREAS, the grant award will be used to purchase automatic external defibrillators (AEDs); and

WHEREAS, if awarded, the City Council agrees to provide a local match in the amount of approximately 10% of the purchase price of \$100,000.

WHEREAS, the City Council authorizes the City Manager, or designee, as the City's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, and if awarded, to accept, reject, alter, or terminate the agreement on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section #1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby approves the acceptance and implementation, if awarded, of the grant award of Assistance to Firefighter Grant Program funding through the Federal Emergency management Agency (FEMA) to purchase automatic external defibrillators (AEDs).

Section #2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage, and it is so resolved.
