

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-XX-XXX (R)

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO APPLY FOR A GRANT FROM THE SMALL COMMUNITY AIR SERVICE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE MCKINNEY NATIONAL AIRPORT AIR SERVICE MARKETING PROGRAM AND ACCEPT FUNDING IF AWARDED; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF

WHEREAS, the Small Community Air Service Development Program (SCASDP), administered by the U.S. Department of Transportation's Office of the Secretary, provides financial assistance, on a competitive basis, to small community airports to help enhance their air service and connect to the national air transportation system,

WHEREAS, the U.S. DOT is making up to \$12 million available for grant awards,

WHEREAS, the funding, if awarded, will be used to implement marketing campaigns and offer financial incentives to airlines to support the development of new nonstop year-round and seasonal air service routes at McKinney National Airport as part of its Air Service Incentive Program (ASIP).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, hereby authorizes the execution of all necessary documents for the submittal of a grant application to the U.S. Department of Transportation under the Small Community Air Service Development in the amount of \$1,600,000 with a local match of \$300,000 for a total project budget of \$1,900,000.
- Section 2. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, authorizes the City Manager, or designee, as the City's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate necessary agreements to carry out the grant objectives described herein.
- Section 3. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, understands the City will be responsible for any cost overruns of the grant award.
- Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
