The Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of McKinney, Texas met in regular session in the Council Chambers, 222 N. Tennessee Street, McKinney, Texas, on Tuesday, February 27, 2024, at 6:00 p.m.

There were ten guests present.

Chairman Cox called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. after determining a quorum was present.

Chairman Cox called for public comments on non-public hearing agenda items. There were none.

Chairman Cox continued the meeting with the Regular Agenda Items and Public Hearings on the agenda.

Araceli Botello, Planner I for the City of McKinney, explained the proposed specific use permit request. She stated that staff recommends approval of the request. Leslie Ford, Ofi Chito, 3224 Collinsworth Street, Ft. Worth, TX, explained the proposed specific use permit request and answered the Commission Members' questions. Chairman Cox opened the public hearing and called for comments. There being none, on a motion by Commission Member Buettner, seconded by Commission Member Conrad, the Commission unanimously voted to close the public hearing and recommend approval of the request per staff's recommendation, with a vote of 6-0-0. Chairman Cox stated that the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission would be forwarded to the City Council for final action at the March 19, 2024 meeting.

Kaitlin Sheffield, Senior Planner for the City of McKinney, explained the proposed rezoning request. She stated that staff recommends approval of the request. The applicant was not present to make a presentation. Cox opened the public hearing and called for comments. There were none. On a motion by Vice-Chairman Lebo, seconded by Commission Member Buettner, the Commission unanimously voted to close the public hearing and recommend approval of the request per staff's recommendation, with a vote of 6-0-0. Chairman Cox stated that the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission would be forwarded to the City Council for final action at the March 19, 2024 meeting.

Jake Bennett, Planner II for the City of McKinney, explained the proposed rezoning request and Staff's concerns. He stated that due to concerns with the proposed multifamily residential use on the subject property, staff recommends denial of the proposed rezoning request. Jennifer Arnold, Director of Planning for the City of McKinney, and Jake Bennett answered the Commissions' questions. Kevin Kuntz, Allen Harrison Co., 8250 N. Central Expressway, Dallas, TX, explained the proposed rezoning request. He answered the Commissions' questions. Chairman Cox opened the public hearing and called for comments. Bucky Gillett, 1100 Dickinson Drive, McKinney, TX, spoke in favor of the request. On a motion by Vice-Chairman Lebo, seconded by Commission Member Conrad, the Commission unanimously voted to close the public hearing, with a vote of 6-0-0. Vice-Chairman Lebo stated that the applicant addressed the concerns on the previous rezoning request from 2023. Commission Member Buettner concurred with Vice-Chairman Lebo's comments. He stated that he was in favor of the request. Chairman Cox stated that he appreciated the applicant addressing the previous concerns. On a motion by Vice-Chairman Lebo, seconded by Commission Member Buettner, the Commission unanimously voted to recommend approval of the request, with a vote of 6-0-0. Chairman Cox stated that the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission would be forwarded to the City Council for final action at the March 19, 2024 meeting.

END OF THE REGULAR AGENDA ITEMS AND PUBLIC HEARINGS

Chairman Cox called for Public Comments regarding matters not on the agenda. There were none.

Chairman Cox called for Commission and Staff Comments. Commission Member Woodard mentioned the McKinney Development Updates 2024 event on March 14, 2024 held by the McKinney Economic Development Corporation (MEDC) and the McKinney Chamber of Commerce. Jennifer Arnold discussed the Texas American Planning Association (APATX24) Conference being held in Allen, TX this October.

On a motion by Vice-Chairman Lebo, seconded by Commission Member Woodard, the Commission unanimously voted to adjourn the meeting, with a vote of 6-0-

0. There being no further business, Chairman Cox declared the meeting adjourned at 6:46 p.m.
