McKinney Community Development Corporation Update

- Promotional and Community Event Grants
 - The first cycle for Promotional grants will open to receive applications November 1-30.
- Retail Development Infrastructure Grants Retail is defined as: storefronts/shops, restaurants, specialty food venues, event venues, salons, grocery stores, drug stores, etc.
 - Grants will fund infrastructure improvements for retail establishments or buildings housing retail enterprises that are <u>exterior to a property</u>, <u>necessary to promote or develop new or</u> <u>expanded business enterprises</u>.
 - Expenses eligible for consideration include:
 - Sewer
 - Water
 - Electric Utilities
 - Gas Utilities
 - Drainage
 - Lighting (for security enhancements)
 - Fencing (for security enhancements)
 - Site Improvements
 - Public hearings on two applications submitted were held at the August 28 meeting. Board action will take place at the September 25 meeting.

RI 25-05	Cotton Mill	Installation of drainage and replacement of concrete with turf for the outdoor wedding venue at The Cotton Mill. Drainage issues have caused damage to the original concrete foundation.	\$	27,458.92

New system to include a nitrogen generator component that will increase the life of the system from 20 to 60 years. The public portion of the garage serves visitors to park, amphitheater, restaurants, and retail shops.	\$ 233,137
25-13	McKinney Main Street	50-foot neon Historic Downtown monument sign to be located at Hwy 75 and Virginia, visible from the highway to North and South travelers, that will serve as a landmark gateway to Downtown.	\$ 80,000
25-14	McKinney Parks & Rec	Accessibility improvements, Trails Plan, Al Ruschhaupt Sports Complex improvements, Old Settler's Park improvements, and Erwin Park improvements.	\$ 8,000,000 FY26 Allocation
5-15	Habitat for Humanity of Collin County	Repair and renovation of three properties: 1304 Garcia (upgrade wheelchair ramp, replace doors and windows, fix leaking roof, install new steps, siding, and skirting) 305 Lively Hill (comprehensive rehabilitation of an existing Habitat home. The property requires extensive renovation) 611 Bumpas (Phase I of a multi-phase plan to include demolishing the existing building, cleaning up the property, and designing the new structures for Phase II)	\$ 305,000
25-16	Entertainment Properties 360, LLC	Enhancements to the public park located in the commercial portion of the West Grove Retail Development to add playscapes, a shade structure, a water feature, trees, public restroom, and WIFI.	\$ 2,000,000
