Wellness Area

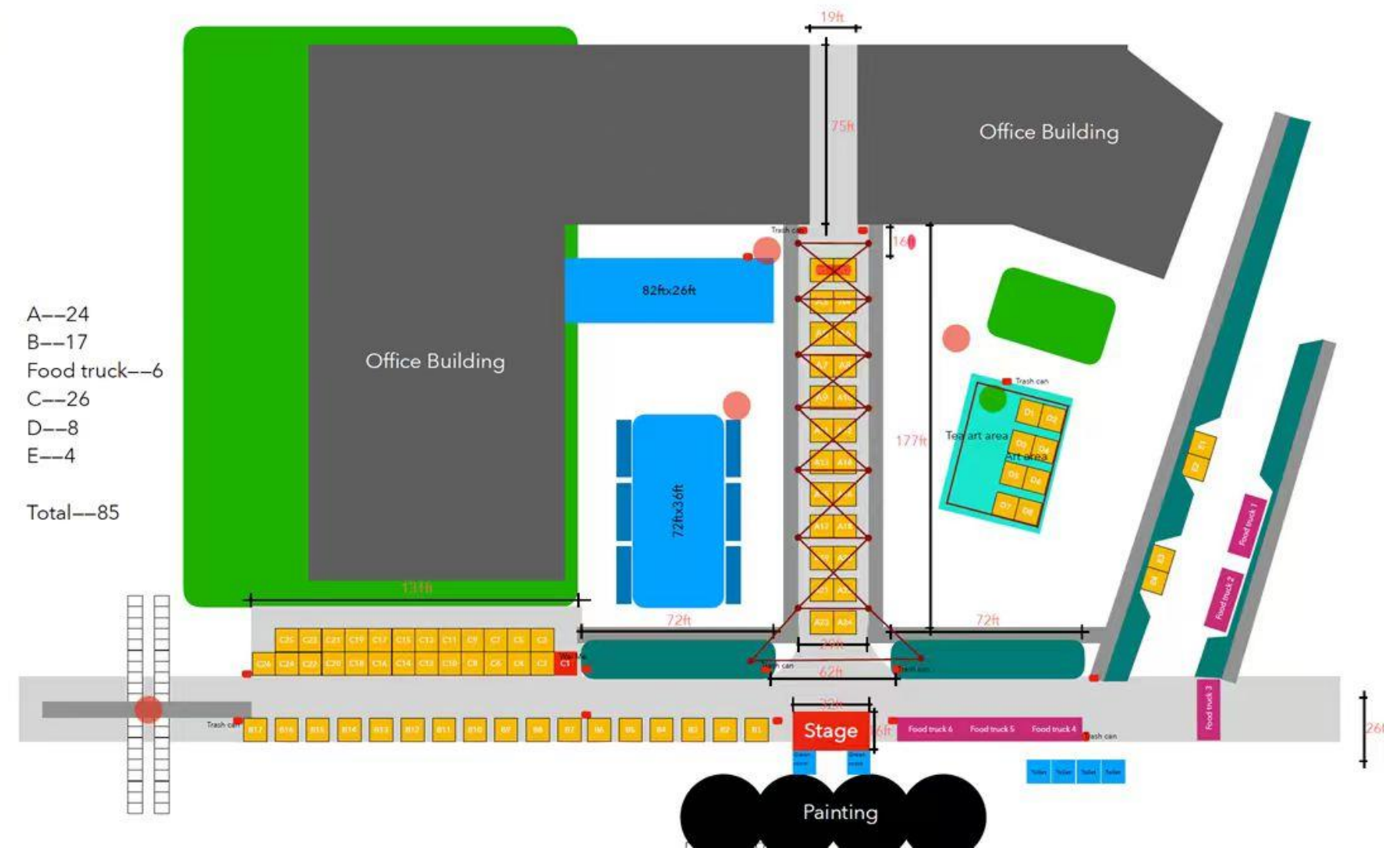
