A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO INITIATE A REQUEST FOR AND FILING ANY RELATED APPLICATIONS WITH THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION, AN OPERATING ADMINISTRATION OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, FOR FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE AUTHORIZED BY 49 U.S.C. CHAPTER 53; TITLE 23, UNITED STATES CODE, OR OTHER FEDERAL STATUTES ADMINISTERED BY THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION FOR DESIGNATION AS A "DIRECT RECIPIENT" AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE RELATED ACTIONS THERETO.

- **WHEREAS**, the Federal Transit Administration has been delegated authority to award federal financial assistance for transportation project funding; and
- WHEREAS, the grant or cooperative agreement for federal financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the applicant, and may require the applicant to provide the local share of certain transportation project costs; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City will provide all annual certifications and assurances to the Federal Transit Administration required for transportation projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT

- Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute and file an application for federal assistance on behalf of the City of McKinney, Texas with the Federal Transit Administration for federal assistance authorized by 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53; Title 23, United States Code; or other federal statutes authorizing a project administered by the Federal Transit Administration to be named a Direct Recipient under 49 U.S.C. 5307. The City Manager's application shall inform the Federal Transit Administration whether the City is the designated recipient or has received authority from the designated recipient to apply for Urbanized Area Formula Program assistance.)
- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute and file with its applications the annual certifications and assurances and other documents the Federal Transportation Administration requires before awarding a federal assistance grant or cooperative agreement.
- Section 3. The City Manager is further authorized to execute grant and cooperative agreements with the Federal Transit Administration on behalf of the City of McKinney, Texas; however, only after such grants and agreements have been approved by the City Council.
- Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
