A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, RECOGNIZING AND ACCEPTING A DONATION FROM BAYLOR SCOTT & WHITE THE HEART HOSPITAL - PLANO SUPPORTING THE ACQUISITION AND MAINTENANCE OF LIFE-SAVING AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS (“AEDs”) FOR USE WITH THE CITY OF MCKINNEY’S NEIGHBORHOOD HEROES PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of McKinney (“City”) is committed to the health, safety, and well-being of its residents; and

WHEREAS, Sudden Cardiac Arrest (“SCA”) is a leading cause of death, with over 200 McKinney residents affected each year—90% of these incidents occurring in the home where life-saving Automated External Defibrillators (“AEDs”) are often unavailable; and

WHEREAS, the first four minutes following a cardiac arrest are critical to survival, making early intervention through CPR and defibrillation essential; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney (“City Council”) has recognized and approved the McKinney Fire Department’s request to establish the Neighborhood Heroes Program as a program that strategically places AEDs into the hands of CPR-trained citizen volunteers to create a robust and connected network of lifesavers across the City in an effort to make the City of McKinney a “4-Minute City”; and

WHEREAS, the Neighborhood Heroes Program is powered by public-private partnerships and generous community contributions to provide AEDs, integrate emergency response technology, and deliver training to citizens; and

WHEREAS, Baylor Scott & White The Heart Hospital - Plano is donating \$450,000 (the “Donation”) to the City of McKinney to become the Platinum Sponsor for the Neighborhood Heroes Program that will enable the McKinney Fire Department to purchase and maintain up to 190 AEDs for the Neighborhood Heroes Program over an initial period of five years; and

WHEREAS, the Donation provided by Baylor Scott & White The Heart Hospital - Plano will empower everyday residents participating in the Neighborhood Heroes Program to become lifesaving responders and significantly improve the odds of survival for victims of cardiac arrest in our community; and

WHEREAS, the Donation provided by Baylor Scott & White The Heart Hospital - Plano will help the City of McKinney progress closer to the goal of the Neighborhood Heroes Program to place more than 400 AEDs in the hands of Neighborhood Heroes across the City and ultimately become a 4-Minute City; and

WHEREAS, the City and the McKinney Fire Department agree, to the extent allowed by applicable law, to share medical data collected from the use of the AEDs funded by the Donation through the McKinney Neighborhood Heroes Program with Baylor Scott & White The Heart Hospital - Plano for medical research purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that accepting the Donation provided by Baylor Scott & White The Heart Hospital - Plano supporting the McKinney Neighborhood Heroes Program is in the best interest of the residents of the City of McKinney, Texas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take all necessary actions to facilitate the receipt and administration of the Baylor Scott & White The Heart Hospital - Plano Donation, and the purchase, distribution, maintenance, and implementation of up to 190 AEDs over the next five years in support of the Neighborhood Heroes Program and the Program's goal to become a 4-Minute City.
- Section 2. The McKinney Fire Department shall oversee the implementation and ongoing management of the Neighborhood Heroes Program including the purchase and maintenance of up to 190 AEDs together with the related medical, technological, and communication software supporting said AEDs funded through the Baylor Scott & White The Heart Hospital - Plano Donation.
- Section 3. The City and the McKinney Fire Department agree, to the extent allowed by applicable law, to share medical data collected from the use of the AEDs funded by the Donation through the McKinney Neighborhood Heroes Program with Baylor Scott & White The Heart Hospital - Plano for medical research purposes.
- Section 4. The City Council again expresses its support and appreciation for Baylor Scott & White The Heart Hospital - Plano's Donation responding to the McKinney Fire Department and community-driven efforts to enhance emergency response capabilities and improve survival rates for sudden cardiac arrest victims in McKinney.
