





Project Timeline

- July 2023: 720 Design contracted to provide initial concepts for renovations.
- May 2024: 720 Design contracted as designer and architect for the renovation project.
- October 2024: Crossland Construction Company selected as CMAR for the project.
- January 2025: Council approved intent to fund the project.
- June2025: Estimation for start of project construction.
- Summer 2026: Project Completion and Grand Re-Opening Celebrations.



Post renovation anticipation:

- Over 100,000 additional downtown visits annually.
- Busier location than John and Judy Gay Library.
- Few seasonal variations.
- Measurable impact on area businesses.
