Sustainability Plan

- The EECBG Grant awarded \$120,000 for development of a community-wide sustainability plan
- The City received 11 submittals to the RFQ from firms across the country
- After interviewing three (3) of those firms, the review committee recommends for selection Gresham, Smith and Partners
