

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-08-XXX (R)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHOURIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF MCKINNEY AND COLLIN COUNTY FOR PRE-INDICTMENT WARRANT SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code, authorizes governmental entities to contract with each other to perform governmental functions and services under the terms thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Collin County Sheriff's Office processes pre-indictment warrants, including entering the warrants into the Texas Crime Information Center (TCIC), validating, managing them, updating them, and, when appropriate, removing them from TCIC ("Services"); and

WHEREAS, Collin County Sheriff's Office has historically handled these Services, however, due to budget cuts Collin County can no longer directly fund the Services; and

WHEREAS, the City of McKinney ("City") desires to pay for and fund the Services for the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of McKinney desires to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with Collin County for the Collin County Sheriff's Office to continue pre- indictment warrant processes for the City of McKinney.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council finds that the recitals made in the preamble of this Resolution are true and correct and incorporates such recitals into the body of this Resolution as if copied in their entirety.

Section 2. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to execute the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement with Collin County for the processing of pre-indictment warrants pursuant to Section 791 of the Texas Government Code.

Section 3. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas hereby authorizes the City Manager to expend yearly funds in the amount of \$34,044.75 to Collin County in exchange for the Collin County Sheriff's Office providing the City of McKinney pre-indictment warrant services.

Section 4. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
