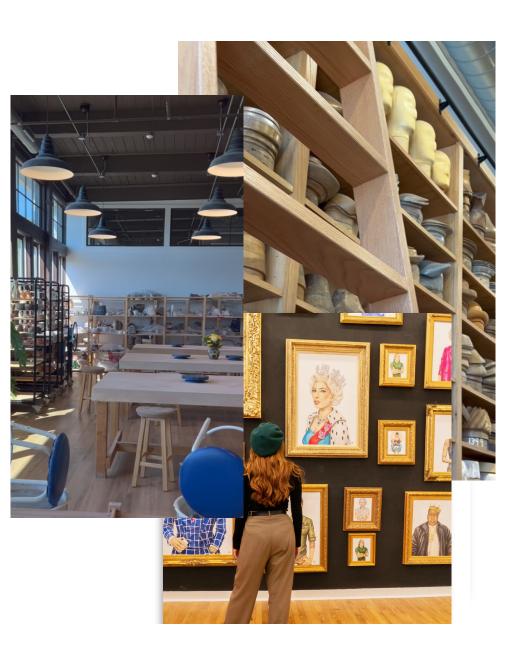

- Free to all visitors of the Cotton Mill





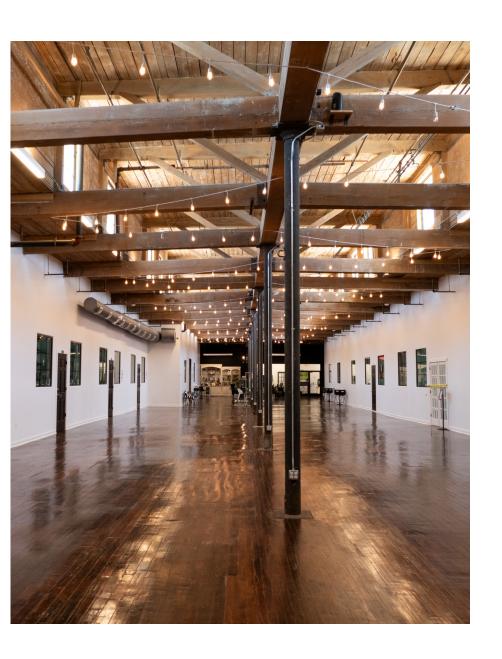
Community & Business Impact
