
The National Community Survey™ in McKinney

The NCS™ for McKinney, TX

- 5th time conducting The NCS (previous survey in 2023, 2021, 2019, 2017)
- Survey conducted from January 31st, 2025 March 5th, 2025
- Mailing approach employed:
 - Probability-based sample of 268 randomly selected households
 - 268 total responses received
 - 5% overall response rate
 - Non-probability, open-participation survey: 443 responses
- Results statistically weighted to reflect McKinney overall
- 95% confidence interval with a +/- 6% margin of error




Facets of Community Livability: Quality











National Ratings for Local Government Trust (2013-2024)














Trends over Time: Increasing/Decreasing Significantly






