Catalytic Converter Theft Prevention Grant Program**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT AND IMPLEMENT CATALYTIC CONVERTER THEFT PREVENTION GRANT PROGRAM GRANT AWARD FROM THE MOTOR VEHICLE CRIME PREVENTION AUTHORITY TO ENHANCE MOTOR VEHICLE CRIME DETECTION AND APPREHENSION FOR THE MCKINNEY POLICE DEPARTMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, under the provisions of the Texas Transportation Code Chapter 1006 and Texas Administrative Code Title 43; Part 3; Chapter 57, entities are eligible to receive grants from the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority to provide financial support to law enforcement taskforces and agencies for economic motor vehicle theft, including catalytic converter theft; and

**WHEREAS**, this grant program will assist this jurisdiction to combat catalytic converter theft; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of McKinney ("City") intends to apply for the Catalytic Converter Theft Prevention Grant through the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority, which will be used to fund the addition of license plate reader cameras and technology services to enhance the McKinney Police Department's detection and apprehension capabilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of McKinney that the 2027 Catalytic Converter Theft Prevention Grant be operated for the 2027 Fiscal Year.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:**

- Section 1. The City Council hereby approves the submission of the Catalytic Converter Theft Prevention grant application to the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority.
- Section 2. The City Council authorizes the City Manager, or his designee, as the grant's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, decline, modify, cancel, or terminate the grant and all other necessary documents to accept said grant on behalf of the City to carry out the grant objectives described herein.
- Section 3. The City Council designates the City's Director of Finance as the grant's financial officer. The financial officer is given the power to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.
- Section 4. The City Council designates the Chief of Police as the grant's Program Director.
- Section 5. The City Council understands the City will be responsible for any cost overruns of the grant award, subject to applicable law.
- Section 6. The City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the grant funds, the City of McKinney assures that the funds will be returned to the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority in full, subject to applicable law.

Section 7. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
