The inaugural Rooted In Rhythm event attracted a diverse and enthusiastic crowd, with attendees from all walks of life coming together to celebrate the vibrant spirit of country music. Despite the inclement weather delays in April and October, the turnout exceeded our expectations, showcasing the unwavering support and dedication of our community. The attendees not only enjoyed captivating performances from talented artists but also engaged with each other, fostering connections and creating an unforgettable atmosphere. Their enthusiasm and resilience highlighted the importance of community and the shared love for music that defines our region. We are grateful to everyone who joined us and made this event a remarkable success!





- Attendance: We sold over 400 tickets to the main event but due to the weather only 257 people showed up. While it is not what we expected, we are far from discouraged because District 121's lawn capacity is 500 and we almost sold it out our first attempt.
- Vendors: 3 of our vendors made over \$800 at the event.
- Additional Activities:
 - Outside of the main festival we held line dance classes at District 121 from April to September led by Tighten Up With Tiff attracting over 600 participants.

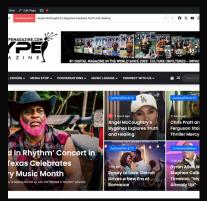

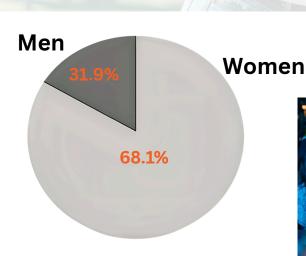

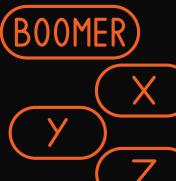
