

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-05-____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, RESTATING THE HOME RULE CHARTER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RESULTS OF THE CHARTER ELECTION HELD ON THE 5TH DAY OF NOVEMBER 2024, PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THE CAPTION HEREOF; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, on its own motion, submitted to the qualified voters of said City for their adoption or rejection thereof certain proposed amendments to the existing Home Rule Charter of said City, pursuant to the provisions of Section 9.004 of the Texas Local Government Code, and

WHEREAS, a special charter election was held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Texas Election Code, and the City Charter of McKinney, Texas as amended; and

WHEREAS, the voters at said election approved Propositions C and D by the margins of votes cast as are further described in Ordinance 2024-11-090 canvassing the election; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to restate the Home Rule Charter in accordance with the charter election to include the textual changes and amendments that were authorized by the voters in said election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS:

Section 1. In accordance with the charter election of November 5, 2024, the City of McKinney Home Rule Charter shall be restated to be and to read according to the text as copied and attached hereto as Exhibit A, incorporated herein as if fully set forth.

Section 2. A copy of the caption of this Ordinance shall be published one time in accordance with applicable law.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage and publication.
