

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-07-XXX (R)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO ACCEPT FUNDING FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2026 FEDERAL CONTRACT TOWER COMPETITIVE GRANT PROGRAM THROUGH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE REHABILITATION OF AGING INFRASTRUCTURE AND EQUIPMENT IN THE AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL TOWER AT MCKINNEY NATIONAL AIRPORT

WHEREAS, the Federal Contract Tower Competitive Grant Program, established under the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law in 2021, has announced close to \$86 million in awards in Fiscal Year 2026, including funding for McKinney National Airport, for the modernization of air traffic control towers.

WHEREAS, McKinney National Airport's federal contract tower was built in 2011 and needs to rehabilitate tower systems and replace outdated equipment that has reached the end of its useful life.

WHEREAS, the funding will be used for various improvement projects at McKinney National Airport's air traffic control tower to help ensure continued safe and efficient air travel, such as replacing the generator transfer switch and communications equipment, rehabilitating the fire panel and mechanical systems, and adding a third controller workstation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, hereby authorizes the execution of all necessary documents for the acceptance of grant funds from the U.S. Department of Transportation through the Federal Contract Tower Competitive Grant Program in an amount not to exceed \$610,000 with no required match.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, authorizes the City Manager, or designee, as the City's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to accept, reject, alter, or terminate necessary agreements to carry out the grant objectives described herein.

Section 3. The City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, understands the City of McKinney, Texas, will be responsible for any cost overruns of the grant award.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
