On behalf of Habitat for Humanity of Collin County, I am writing to formally request an extension for Home Repair Grant #23-15.

As you know, this grant was originally awarded in 2023 for \$400,000. We have used \$361,034.70 to support critical home repair efforts within our community. We currently have a remaining balance of \$38,965.30, which we are requesting to retain and utilize for:

- Material Cost for our new '*Paint It Forward*' Project
- Begin repairs on the container homes at Cotton Groves

While we have made meaningful progress under this grant, additional time is needed to fully expend the remaining funds in a way that aligns with both program goals and the needs of the families we serve. This extension will allow us to continue delivering impactful repairs and ensure that all funds are used responsibly and effectively.

We respectfully request an extension through December 31, 2026. Habitat for Humanity of Collin County remains committed to transparency, compliance, and maximizing the benefit of these funds for the community.
