Background & ILA

- Established to assist the Collin County Animal Shelter in complying with the requirements of **Section 823.005 of the Texas Health and Safety Code**
- Animal Shelter located in McKinney, operated solely by Collin County
- Interlocal Agreement (ILA) for use of Collin County Animal Shelter:
 - **“5.01 County Authority** – “County has exclusive authority over the operation of the Shelter”



Committee Transition

- Commissioner's Court discussion in April
- **Open Application period in May**
 - **No representative seats for cities**
 - **Appointments based on individual qualifications**
- Appointment of new members summer 2026
- **New committee assumes full legal responsibilities October 1, 2026**
- Staff recommends bringing the work of the board to a close



Next Steps

- Staff will continue collaboration with the County Animal Shelter
 - **Adoption initiatives, operational activities, community outreach opportunities**
- **No impact** to level of service provided to McKinney residents
 - Timely, compassionate, and high-quality support for animal related incidents and concerns
