McKinney Community Development Corporation Update

Promotional and Community Event Grants

Applications for the first cycle of FY 25 Promotional Grants were accepted November 1-29,
 2024, and were presented to the board at the December 19 meeting. Board members voted on the requests at the January 23, 2025 meeting. A summary of grant funds awarded is included.

Project Grants

- Applications for the first cycle of FY 25 Project Grants were accepted December 1-31, 2024.
 Public hearings, on requests eligible for consideration by MCDC, were held at the January 23, 2025. Board action is scheduled for the February 27, 2025 meeting.
- A summary of project grant applications received is included.

Retail Development Infrastructure Grants

- The Retail Development Infrastructure Grants will fund infrastructure improvements, for retail establishments or buildings housing a retail enterprise, that are <u>exterior to a property</u>, <u>necessary to promote or develop new or expanded business enterprises</u>, and include:
 - Sewer
 - Water
 - Electric Utilities, Gas Utilities
 - Drainage
 - Lighting (for security enhancements)
 - Fencing (for security enhancements)
 - Site Improvements
 - (landscape <u>only considered if replacement required due to infrastructure improvements</u>)
 - Walkways concrete or other materials
 - Parking
 - Fire suppression systems however, requests for funding for fire suppression from businesses in the downtown historical district, are to be made to the City of McKinney Planning Department – TIRZ Grant program.
- Applications for the first cycle of FY Retail Development Infrastructure Grants were accepted January 1-31, 2025. Public hearings, on requests eligible for consideration by MCDC, will be held at the February 27, 2025 meeting with board action scheduled for the March 27, 2025 meeting. A summary of requests received is included.

Retail is defined as: storefronts/shops, restaurants, specialty food venues, event venues, salons, grocery stores, drug stores, etc.

RI25-03	Construct wrought iron fencing to surround the perimeter of the Inn Style Resale Shop which is a vital source of revenue for the Samaritan Inn.
