

Construction and Preservation Priority

- Constructed: c. 1898
 - Wood frame construction
 - Gable roof
- Priority: High
- Style: Folk Victorian

Historical Information

- Owned by Dr. Scott Harrison Abbott who used it as a rental property until 1911
- Purchased in 1911 by Wellington Charles “Will” Garrish and used as a permanent home for his family
- Between 1908-14, rear additions and a second story were added
- Property changed hands several times in the latter half of the twentieth Century




Historical Information

- Substantial rehabilitation by Tom & Barbara Swing in 1979
- Several changes between 1985-2005 including removal of a carport, a third peak on the roof, and a set of upstairs windows
- Interior and exterior preservation efforts in 1996 by owners William and Rosie Huges
- Property purchased by current owners in 2024




Above: 1902 Sanborn Map




