- Address growing **waitlist of 400+** (double capacity)
- Expand as a **Knowledge Center**
- Grow as a **Community Center**
- Serve the McKinney community for the next **50+ years!**

Annual Impact of The Beacon Project

Community Center

- 4,000 Event Attendees
- 1,200 Adult Volunteers
- 800 Student Volunteers
- 500 Corporate / Service Orgs.

Equine Therapy & Brain-Building Center

- 750 Family Members
- 400 Riders with Disabilities
- 50 Veteran Participants
- 40 Therapy Horses

Knowledge Center

- 375 instructors, therapists, and nonprofit professionals trained at ManeGait



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The Plan:

- 2nd Riding Arena
- Admin Building
- Brain-Building Therapy Center
- 32-Stall Barn
- 75-seat Conference Space
- Patriot's Patio
- **Community Event Plaza and Walking Trail**

Total Budget: \$10,229,746 (56% Raised)



COMMUNITY EVENT PLAZA

MCDC Grant Request:

- \$500,000
- .4-acre Community Event Plaza
- .3-mile walking trail

Includes:

- artificial turf
- concrete surround
- shade sails
- picnic tables and benches
- sensory playboards

(cont.)



Community Event Plaza (cont.):

- relocating 3 mature live oaks to enhance Plaza with West sun protection - otherwise these trees would be enveloped by new buildings
- lighting, electricity, audio system
- temporary stage for smaller events
- landscaping and deconstructed granite walking trail

Timeline

- Jan - Mar '24 - prep work for arena construction
- Mar '24 - **site work for event plaza**, trails, and arena
- April - May '24 - new arena construction
- May '24 - Aug '24 - site work for barn and new admin building
- Sept '24 - Aug '25 - construction of new admin building and barn
- Aug - Nov '25 - **event plaza construction**, landscaping, trails, driveways

Alignment with MCDC Goals

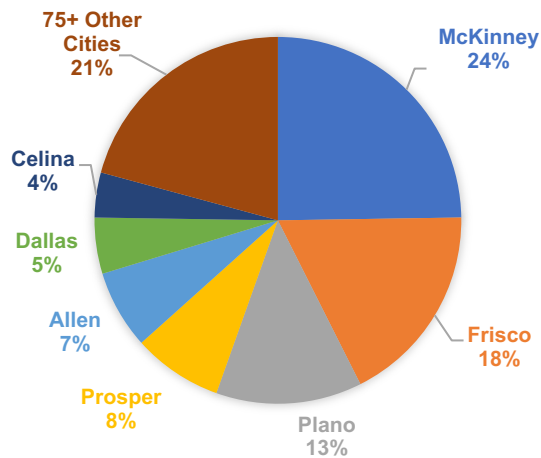
- **Sports and athletic facilities**
 - equestrian sports facility – serving youth & adults with disabilities
 - venue for Special Olympics and equestrian competitions
- **Projects related to recreational or community facilities**
 - community event plaza
 - venue for festivals, school outings, picnics, and corporate retreats
 - individual and group (corporate) volunteer opportunities
- **Public parks and open space improvements**
 - like McKinney, ManeGait is “Unique by Nature”
 - refuge for the entire community, pastoral setting (not residential/commercial)
 - open for public use during ManeGait operating hours & special events
- **Entertainment, tourist, and convention facilities.**
 - host industry workshops and conferences (national)
 - ManeGait community events (regional)
 - visitors from North Texas & all over the U.S.
 - refer guests to McKinney lodging and dining



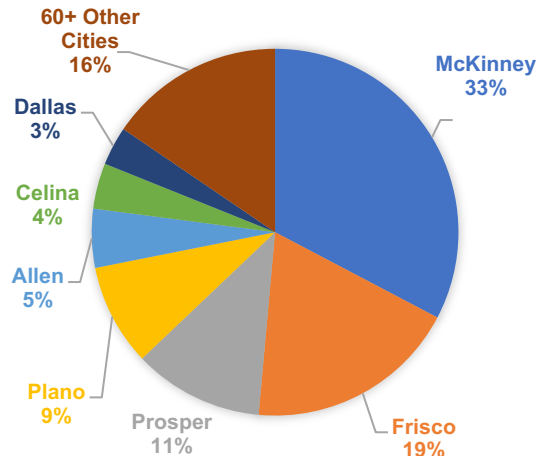
Service to the McKinney Community

- McKinney residents make up the largest population currently served

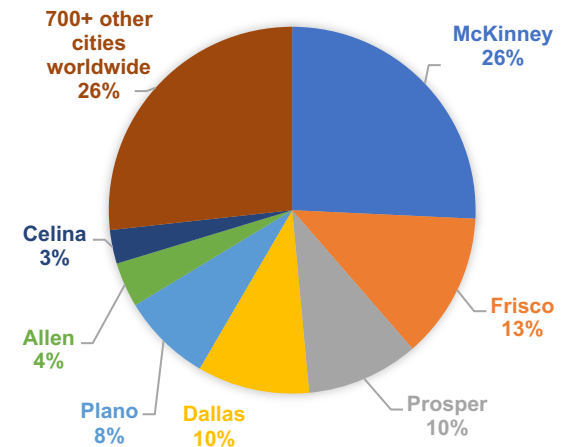
ALL PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS
