

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-10-___ (R)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AGREEING TO RETURN \$2,095,442 OF TREASURY CARES ACT FUNDING, FOR THE EMERGENCY HOUSING AND LIVING ASSISTANCE (EHLA) GRANT FUND, TO COLLIN COUNTY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, On June 2, 2020, the City Council accepted CARES Act Funding from Collin County, through the Department of the Treasury, in the amount of \$6,889,619 for the Emergency Housing and Living Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, unused funds, as of December 30, 2020, must be returned to the Department of the Treasury; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney agrees to return \$2,095,442 of these funds to the County so that they may be fully utilized by other County-wide programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The following funding revisions for the City of McKinney Collin County EHLA CARES Act funding are hereby adopted:
