DECEMBER 3, 2025

The Community Grants Advisory Commission of the City of McKinney, Texas met in regular session in the City Hall Virginia Conference Room, 401 E. Virginia Street, McKinney, Texas on December 3, 2025, at 6:30 p.m.

Board Chair Tammy Thornton-Chewe called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. upon determining a quorum consisting of Board Chair Tammy Thornton-Chewe and the following Board Members: Andrea Harvey-Rogers, Eniola Campbell, Barbara Kelly, Derrick D. Tarver, Nicholas Dangerfield, and Sally Riche.

25-3430 Conduct a Public Hearing on Grant Applications for the FY 2026 Opioid Settlement Fund

Chairperson Thornton-Chewe opened the public hearing and provided instructions to the presenter(s): Each agency representative will provide up to a maximum time of three minutes for their presentation. Following the presentation, Commissioners may or may not wish to ask questions. The application for the FY 2026 Opioid Settlement Fund Grant was as follows: Shannon White presented on behalf of Grace to Change, requesting a minimum of \$25,000 funding to support each of five (5) staff salary. The organization provides substance abuse outpatient program for teens and adults.

As there were no other presentations, Commissioner Chewe closed the public hearing.

25-3431 Deliberations on Grant Applications for the FY 2026 Opioid Settlement Fund

Housing and Community Director, Margaret Li provided an explanation of the process; Commissioners can recommend funding for the total or portion of the budget, or reissue. There was only one application

received, and the total budget is \$53,785. After discussion and consideration, the Commissioners unanimously approved the motion made by Commissioner Campbell seconded by Commissioner Riche to approve 100% of the funding to the organization, Grace to Change. Commissioners unanimously approved the motion by Commissioner Harvey-Rodgers, seconded by Commissioner Dangerfield to adjourn the meeting. The meeting adjourned at 7:00 p.m.
