EVENT BACKGROUND

The 26th annual Christmas Parade of Lights took place on December 13, 2025 marking another successful collaboration between the McKinney Rotary Club and City of McKinney. All proceeds from float entry fees and local business sponsorships are contributed directly to the McKinney Rotary Foundation. **These funds are subsequently awarded to local charitable organizations,** ensuring the event's impact extends far beyond the day's entertainment.

With continued support from MCDRC, the parade strengthens community connections, supports charitable causes, and offers memorable experiences for residents and visitors alike.





EVENT CONCLUSION

In total, the McKinney Rotary Club raised \$19,890 from sponsorships and participants in the 2025 parade of lights. With the MCDC grant of 7,500.00, the McKinney Rotary foundation will have a **net profit of \$ 14,825***.
