## McKinney Community Development Corporation Update

- **Promotional and Community Event Grants**

- Applications for the first cycle of Promotional grants were accepted through November 28.
- Fourteen applications were received (summary attached).
- Applications were presented to the board at the December 18<sup>th</sup> meeting. Board action will take place on January 22<sup>nd</sup>.
- Maximum award is \$15,000 and is restricted to advertising, marketing and promotional activities.

- **Project Grants**

- Applications for the first cycle of Project grants were accepted through December 30.
- Public hearings are scheduled for the January 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting on eligible projects.
- Board action will be scheduled for the February 26<sup>th</sup> meeting.
- Summary of project grant applications received is attached.

- **Retail Development Infrastructure Grants**

- Applications for the first cycle of Retail Development Infrastructure grants will be accepted through January 30<sup>th</sup>.
- Public hearings will be scheduled for the February 26<sup>th</sup> meeting on eligible grant requests.
- Board action will be scheduled for the March 26<sup>th</sup> meeting.
- Matching grant program, up to 75% of eligible expenses with a maximum award of \$50,000.
- Eligible projects are restricted to exterior infrastructure – sewer, water, utilities, site work.
