RE: PCO02 Narrative

PCO02 encompasses various scopes of work that are deemed additional work items not included in the base contract:

- 1.Rulon Replacement Prior to default, the drawings, including fire suppression, were submitted, reviewed and approved by the appropriate entities with the City of McKinney. The Rulon system that is currently installed was also submitted and approved by the design team and owners. After takeover of the contract, areas of concern with the Rulon, as identified by the obligee/design team, were removed, and replaced with newly purchased materials at the expense of NMCO. On May 26th, 2023, it was brought to our attention by the McKinney Fire Marshal, that the Rulon installed under the canopies at the main entry and air side entry do not comply with the required NFPA fire rating that allows it to be installed without a fire suppression system. After further investigation by NMCO, Owner and the Design team, it was decided that the most practical path forward was to remove and replace the installed system with the Alumination Plank system that meets the NFPA requirements to be installed without a fire suppression system. On July 26, 2023, we received directions from the City to move forward with AIS and the replacement material. AIS provided a 12-week schedule for procurement of the replacement materials. Taking into consideration the procurement lead time, plus the appropriate time to install the materials upon arrival, we estimate a completion deadline of the replacement materials to be October 31, 2023. As outlined, all drawings and installed materials went through the proper approval channels and were installed per the contact documents. The Fire Marshal's failure of the Rulon System was based on the material's fire rating, not deficient construction or installation. Therefore, the requirement for the modification of the Rulon System is additional to the contracted scope and requires a change order to proceed.
- 2.Mesh Cabinets at Bar The mesh cabinets were incorporated with WCPR#5 and cannot be determined if they were incorporated into the contract documents. It was discussed previously that work not yet completed revolving around WCPRs, could not be verified and would bear additional costs to complete.
- 3.Additional Concrete work The additional concrete work stems from areas of concern from the owner that was not identified during the time of take over. This work includes removal and replacement of flatwork and removal and replacement of thresholds. Additional pedestals, curb and pads for gate controls. Additional surveying for the sitework in the front of the building which identified C&G/inlets set at incorrect elevations requires modifications. Additional

- surveying requested to provide as-builts of work previously installed to satisfy engineering inspections and Certificate of Occupancy.
- 4.Dryer vent, Water connection and RPZ in flight prep These were again modifications that occurred through WCPR#5 and cannot be determined if they were incorporated into the contract documents. It was discussed previously that work not yet completed revolving around WCPRs, could not be verified and would bear additional costs to complete.
- 5.Missing Door Hardware the specified hardware and closers for the doors with wood transom did not function properly for the application. Thus, new door closers and miscellaneous hardware were required to allow the doors to function properly. Two doors into the boiler rooms were identified by the state boiler inspector as swinging the incorrect direction per code requirements. Our contractor was required to remove and re-install the doors to swing in the proper direction along with new closers to be installed.
- 6.Metal Cap on Glass Raining The glass railing company strongly recommended that a metal extrusion cap be installed on the top edge of the glass railing. This was never identified on the contract drawings but was deemed necessary by all parties for the appearance and longevity of the railing.
- 7.Repair Gate 10 McKinney airport requested that prior to the Byron Nelson event that Gate 10 be made operational, as over the course of the project the facility borrowed parts for use on other gates. This gate was not included to have any associated work per the contract drawings.


