

COMMUNITY GRANTS ADVISORY COMMISSION

NOVEMBER 16, 2023

The Community Grants Advisory Commission of the City of McKinney, Texas met in regular session in the 2nd Floor Conference Room, City Hall, 222 N. Tennessee Street, McKinney, Texas on November 16, 2023, at 6:30 p.m.

Vice-Chair Schmitz called the meeting to order at 6:32 p.m. upon determining a quorum was present. Commissioners Present: Chris Thornton, Silvia Escamilla, Aaron Schmitz, Tammy Chewe, Nicholas Dangerfield, Jaymie Pedigo

There were 0 members of the public present in the audience.

- 23-0942** Minutes of the Community Grants Advisory Commission of October 18, 2023. Board members unanimously approved the motion by Commissioner Dangerfield, seconded by Commissioner Thornton, to approve and refer the Minutes of the Community Grants Advisory Committee Meeting of October 18, 2023.
- 23-0767** Vice-Chair Schmitz called for Consider/Discuss/Act on application from Fahma Humanitarian Organization International, Inc. Mrs. Best informed the board that the application was not eligible for funding under the Opioid Settlement Fund. Commissioners were able to review the application and discuss. Board members unanimously approved the motion to deny, by Commissioner Dangerfield, second by Commissioner Thornton. Ms. Best stated the applicant, could be eligible for other grant fund considerations and would receive information.
- 23-0943** Vice-Chair Schmitz called for Consider/Discuss on an Update of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Consolidated Annual Performance Evaluation Report (CAPER), Program Year 2022-23. Mrs. Best gave an update on activities and performance, the Program Year goals and outcomes. The CAPER will be under public comment and will

move to the City Council meeting for the public hearing. She also presented information on the Community Services Grants (CSG). The public comment period begins November 16 to December 6.

Commissioners unanimously approved the motion by Commissioner Dangerfield, second by Commissioner Chewe, to adjourn the meeting. The meeting adjourned at 7:32 p.m.
