A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT NUMBER 5 WITH JOHNSON, MIRMIRAN AND THOMPSON, INC. FOR ADDITIONAL ENGINEERING DESIGN SERVICES FOR THE VIRGINIA AND THROCKMORTON INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS (MUNICIPAL COMPLEX) PROJECT FOR AN INCREASE IN THE NOT TO EXCEED FEE FROM \$1,350,000 TO A TOTAL AGGREGATE CONTRACT AMOUNT, INCLUSIVE OF ANY ADDITIONAL SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENTS, NOT TO EXCEED \$1,450,000

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas, recognizes the need for the additional design services for the Virginia and Throckmorton Infrastructure Improvements (Municipal Complex) Project (CIP Projects ST2235, WA2235, and WW2235); and

WHEREAS, the City has received a proposal from Johnson, Mirmiran and Thompson, Inc. to provide additional design services for the Virginia and Throckmorton Infrastructure Improvements (Municipal Complex) Project (CIP Projects ST2235, WA2235, and WW2235).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a supplemental agreement number 5 with Johnson, Mirmiran and Thompson, Inc. to provide additional professional engineering services for the design of the Virginia and Throckmorton Infrastructure Improvements (Municipal Complex) Project (CIP Projects ST2235, WA2235, and WW2235) for an increase in the not to exceed fee from \$1,350,000 to a total aggregate contract amount, inclusive of any additional supplemental agreements, not to exceed \$1,450,000.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and is so resolved.
