## **RESOLUTION NO. 2023-10-\_\_\_ (R)**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE NORTH CENTRAL TEXAS EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS DISTRICT (NCT 9-1-1) TO OPERATE AND MAINTAIN THE SYSTEMS UTILIZED FOR THE PROVISION OF 9-1-1 EMERGENCY COMMUNICATION SERVICES, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

- **WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of McKinney, Texas strives to provide a safe and secure community for its residents; and
- WHEREAS, the City of McKinney is a local government that operates one or more Public Service Answering Points (PSAPs) that assist in implementing the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) Strategic Plan to establish and maintain 9-1-1 emergency telephone services; and
- WHEREAS, the North Central Texas Emergency Communications District (NCT 9-1-1)
  Board of Managers approved an Interlocal Agreement on June 6, 2019 to which the City of McKinney is a party; and
- WHEREAS, the City of McKinney desires to renew the Interlocal Agreement with NCT 9-1-1 concerning the provision of 9-1-1 emergency communication services, effective October 1, 2023 to September 30, 2025; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

- Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager, or his designee, to execute an interlocal agreement with the NCT 9-1-1 for the operation and maintenance of systems utilized for the provision of 9-1-1 emergency communication services.
- Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after the date of passage and it is so resolved.
